

Licence to Fell Growing Trees

To: Mr O Kebbell, Affinity Woodland Workers Cooperative Ltd, Steward Community Woodland, Moretonhampstead, Devon, TQ13 8SD

This conditional licence gives you permission under section 10 of the Forestry Act 1967 as amended to fell the trees described below and shown on the attached map.

This licence expires on: 30/01/2013

You should tell others involved with the felling about the details in this licence - e.g. by giving a copy of the licence and map to the person felling the trees. If you sell the land you should also tell the new owner about this licence. If a Tree Preservation Order is placed on these trees after this licence has been issued, you must also get the consent of the Local Authority before felling the trees.

NOTE In England and Wales, a felling licence will not cover the felling of trees to which a Tree Preservation Order applies, or which are in a Conservation area, if you have not declared the existence of the Order or Area in the application.

PART 2 - Restocking Conditions

This licence is granted subject to the following conditions.

-The following conditions apply to the licenced felling in cpt 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10.

1. Before 30th June 2013 the land on which the felling took place must be:

a. Cleared of lop and top.

b. Planted with:

Cpt 1 - Sweet chestnut (30%), Ash (20%), Apple (20%), Fir (10%), Larch (10%), Woody shrub (10%)

Cpt 3 - Apple (100%)

Cpt 4 - Sweet chestnut (45%), Ash (45%), Woody shrub (10%)

Cpt 5 - Sweet chestnut (40%), Ash (40%), Apple (10%), Mixed broadleaves 10%

Cpt 8 - Sweet chestnut (40%), Ash (40%), Birch (10%), Fir (10%)

Cpt 9 - Ash (20%), Sweet chestnut (20%), Apple (20%), Hazel (10%), Larch (10%), Fir (10%), Birch (10%)

Cpt 10 - Oak (70%), Ash (20%), Woody shrub (10%)

to achieve not less than 1100 plants per hectare evenly distributed over the sites

2. For a period of 10 years from the planting:

a. The plants must be protected against damage and be adequately weeded.

b. Any failure or losses should be replaced as necessary to provide a stocking of not less than 1100 plants per hectare evenly distributed over the sites.

c. And all must be maintained in accordance with the rules and practice of good forestry.

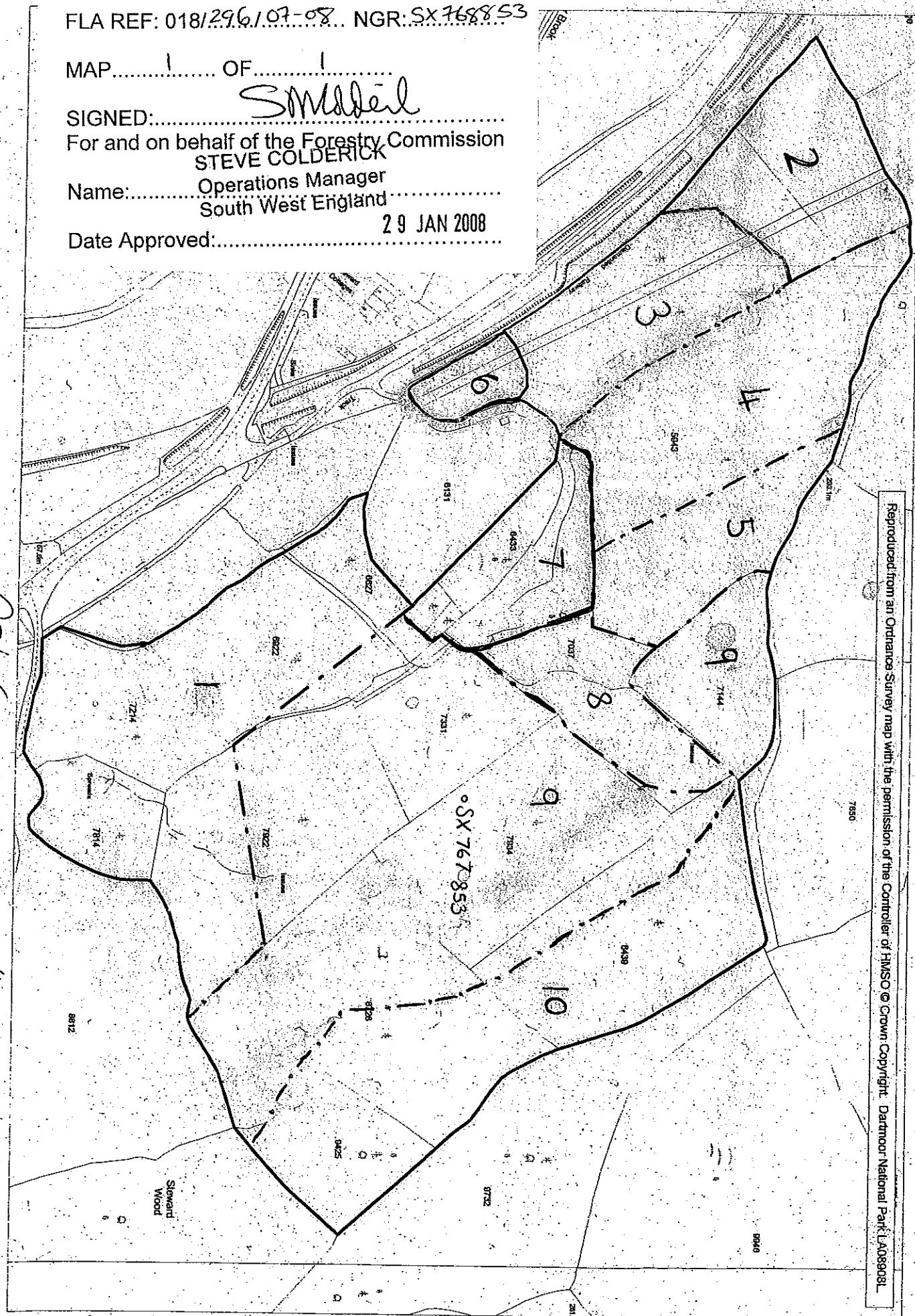
